Celebrate the 350th anniversary of Jewish Settlement in the US by reviewing colonial Jewish American history. The course will spot light dynamic personalities, dramatics events and special places from 1654 to the early 1800's. The class will teach librarians and educators how to engage their students through an overview of how to focus on the actual history. The lecturer Ellen Cole, Library Educator of the Levine Library of Temple Isaiah, Los Angeles, CA., will share with you the nuts and bolts of her library programs: the conception, preparation, content, rules and publicity on exploring our colonial history.
