GETTING TO CONVENTION

Two convenient airports service the Northeast Ohio region: Cleveland Hopkins International Airport and the Akron-Canton Airport. Taxis are always available near the baggage pick-up area.

Shuttle service from Cleveland Hopkins costs approximately \$50.00 each way for a town car or \$60 for a van that holds up to 14 people.
